According to [collectivenounslist.com](http://collectivenounslist.com), a “Loom of Weavers” refers to a gathering or group of skilled craftspeople who practice the traditional art form of weaving. On May 10 and 11 (Friday and Saturday) we will gather for a “Loom of Weavers” at the South Valley Unitarian Universalist Society, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. each day. We will gather to weave and share what we are working on.

This event was prompted by the cancellation of a three-day workshop for weaving the painted warps dyed with Denise Kovnat’s recent Zoom class. All weaving or other fiber-related projects are welcome, and you don’t need a painted warp to participate.

As we will be assembling with our looms in the space where we hold our meetings, we do not have unlimited space, so the group will be limited to 25 and a fee of \$20 will be charged to cover the cost of the room and Ivy’s costs. If you are planning on coming, please complete the attached signup sheet and send it to Maureen Wilson. The fee will be collected at the Gathering. Lunch plans are under development.

Ivy DeHart, from the Guild’s Southern Utah Branch, will speak to us on Saturday morning at 10:00 a.m. She will be talking about her process of designing a weaving around a painted warp and finding the weaving structure that works best for that warp.
